

BTEC Increased Flexibility

Chiltern Training is working in partnership with Thames Valley University and local schools to provide an Increased Flexibility BTEC course to young people. The course is for Year 10 and 11 learners who are still at school. The course lasts for two years and learners come to us once a week. After an initial induction period of 4 weeks at college, Increased Flexibility learners spend alternate weeks at the college or at a nursery placement to gain hands on experience of working with children. This means that they will spend one day every two weeks at a nursery.

Increased Flexibility learners are likely to need additional support when at nursery, as they will only be there once every two weeks and they are younger than Apprenticeship learners. They will be given a log book which will need to be signed by their manager every time they attend their placement. The nursery should also receive a telephone call on the days that the IF learners are expected to be there, to ensure that we know where they are.
